MATTER: MARITIME SAFETY MESSAGES

DATE: JUNE 5th, 2018

We hereby inform that the Panama Maritime Authority maintains the Navarea 471/2017 maritime safety message active since May 23rd, 2017 with the following information:

Navigation is prohibited within an area of 0.5 nautical miles, from position 9° 25.53' North and 079° 52.09' West.

In this sense, maritime safety messages have the priority of safeguarding human life at sea, to avoid risks to navigation, to prevent pollution, and to protect cargo.

Finally, we reiterate the contents of Circular DGPIMA/CCP/029/2017, same which is published in our Web Site, and it encourages to stay alert to all maritime safety messages which have been issued.
