



# REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE MEDICAL EXAMINATION PROCEDURE



Requirements for physicians in the following countries:

Republic of the Philippines, Republic of India, Republic of Indonesia, Republic of Korea (South Korea), Socialist Republic of Vietnam and Republic of the Union of Myanmar.

Based on ADM Resolution No. 033-2021 dated March 25, 2021, as amended by ADM Resolution No. 006-2023 dated January 12, 2023.

Written request addressed to the General Directorate of Seafarers.

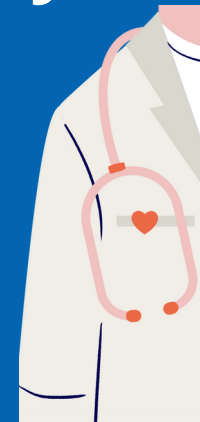

Authenticated copy of the authorization to issue medical certificates to seafarers issued by the State Maritime Administration or competent health authority, where medical examinations of seafarers are performed, in accordance with the STCW'78 Convention, as amended, and the Maritime Labor Convention, 2006, as amended.

3.

Authenticated photocopy of the Certificate of Suitability as a recognized physician issued by the Ministry, Institution or Authority of the Country which is responsible for issuing the certification.

Updated resume with your general data. (address, telephone, mail, work experience, accreditations of studies or courses received)

Proof of payment of the corresponding fee as approved by the Panama Maritime Authority. Make the payment for the process in the amount of 300.00 USD (Three hundred dollars)

Copy of quality procedures or guidelines

5.

Description of the clinical facility and inventory of equipment necessary to meet all medical examination requirements set forth in the National Guidelines for the Conduct of Seafarers' Medical Examinations.

**These documents must be submitted to the Panamanian Embassy or Consulate in your country to be verified and countersigned. Once they are submitted, they will be forwarded to our office at our main office in Panama.**
